Analysis

As we were mentioning yesterday, the rebound came quickly without breaking the minor stop that lies at 10,850. The EGX 30 closed above 11,000 and is going once again to challenge the 11,100 level, which is the upper boundary of this tight range.

If the market rises today, we will have a big probability of a confirmed breakout above 11,100, which will lead the index to the more important resistance at 11,500.


It is important to watch the market today; a positive close today will be seen as bullish on the short-term.

Egyptian Exchange Small Caps Index .EGX 70

Analysis

The break above 2,050-2,060 is a bullish sign for the EGX 70 index; if this breakout is confirmed today, the index will probably witness a strong rise as new 5 years high will be recorded.

Those who trade small caps can step in at this breakout, using tight stops; holding positions, as long as the index is in an uptrend can be done but with outperforming stocks.





Resistance



Broke 2.6 yesterday with very high volumes, and triggered an important buy signal. Those who want to step in can buy with a stop below 2.5 and a target at 3.



Broke 3.35 to the upside and closed clearly above it. ARCC looks strong and is expected to reach 4, especially if it continues trading above 3.4-3.5 today.

Support

No stocks broke their support yesterday

Testing

Support





Rebounded from its support that lies at 5.8 and closed clearly higher. The stock is on its way to break 6.55-6.6 upwards. A breakout above this level will trigger a new buy signal with a target around 7.5.

Resistance





The 11.35 is a resistance for EAST. If the stock breaks above this level, it will probably close the gap and reach around 12.5. Those who want to step in can buy at the breakout above 11.35.

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Tips on reading the report

The first page includes an analysis of two major indices in the Egyptian Stock Market; the norm is that we will analyze both the EGX 30 and 70, but sometimes we will compare the EGX 30 to its 50 counterpart if there is important information in this comparison. We also use the Hermes Last Index interchangeably with the EGX 30. The .HRMSL index has an important edge; it uses last prices instead of VWAP. First thing our clients should do is to read the indices analysis carefully to have a clear understanding on our overall view.

The second page includes stocks that broke out beyond their resistance levels, and those that violated their support levels. It also includes stocks that are testing their support levels and those that are testing their resistance. This analysis is important and it is the core of our recommendations. It is important to note though that not all stocks that are testing their support levels are bullish, and not all that are testing their resistance levels are bearish. To make it easier for our clients, we have placed a bull face if we consider the stock under study bullish, and a bear face if we consider it bearish. We also added a big bullet if we are neutral.

It is important to note that you might find a stock that we consider bullish in our analysis (in the breakouts/testing section) but it remains as a hold or partial sell in the table. The conflict here is that the table is more conservative. This will not be an issue with our clients, because our analysis will explain why we are being bullish/bearish on the stock.
