Analysis

Yesterday was a breakout day as the EGX 30 broke its historical peak to close above 21,000, and confirming the 20,500 breakout. The rise came with a handful of stocks rising, led by the outperformers that were already expected to continue their strength. Nothing witnessed a surprise move as all stocks that rose sharply were already the strongest in the market.

We will alter our trailing stop to be below 20,300, which is the low of yesterday's session. No upward targets, which is the best strategy to use; not to have targets with stocks and markets that hit new highs. Real life proved this strategy to be the most successful.


For those who want to use a closer stop, we will watch how the market will perform today to see if we can place a stop that is closer to market prices or not.

EGX Small Caps Index/ EGX 70

Analysis

After it broke the 3,735 level to the upside on Sunday, the EGX 70 continued its rise yesterday to close at 3,800, and approaching its resistance that lies at 3,850.

Our stop for now will be placed below 3,735; this stop will be altered as the index moves upwards. We will watch how it will react as it approaches the 3,850 level; a confirmed break above this level will be an early signal of hitting new highs.





Resistance



Closed at 16.61 after it broke 16 to the upside. The stock hit new historical highs and expected to continue its rise; our trailing stop will be placed below 15.5.

EKHOA



Still rising and reaching new highs; EKHOA is one of the strong performers and still expected to continue its major uptrend. Buying dips with a stop below 45 is recommended.



Broke 26.7 to the upside and closed at 27.5. HDBK also is hitting new historical highs and not expected to witness a strong correction in the time being. One of the buy and hold stocks.

If it breaks above 25.5. a buy signal will be triggered. We recommend investors to step in at the breakout with a stop below the low of the breakout day.



A break above 4.6 will trigger a short-term entry signal with a target at 5.1. FWRY is one of the bad performers in the market but might witness a rise along with the other stocks.


The prices that are accompanied by a green arrow in the above table show resistance levels. Thus, a break above these levels will pave the way to achieve one (or all) of the targets.

Tips on reading the report

The first page includes an analysis of two major indices in the Egyptian Stock Market; the norm is that we will analyze both the EGX 30 and 70, but sometimes we will compare the EGX 30 to its 50 counterpart if there is important information in this comparison. We also use the Hermes Last Index interchangeably with the EGX 30. The .HRMSL index has an important edge; it uses last prices instead of VWAP. First thing our clients should do is to read the indices analysis carefully to have a clear understanding on our overall view.

The second page includes stocks that broke out beyond their resistance levels, and those that violated their support levels. It also includes stocks that are testing their support levels and those that are testing their resistance. This analysis is important and it is the core of our recommendations. It is important to note though that not all stocks that are testing their support levels are bullish, and not all that are testing their resistance levels are bearish. To make it easier for our clients, we have placed a bull face if we consider the stock under study bullish, and a bear face if we consider it bearish. We also added a big bullet if we are neutral.

It is important to note that you might find a stock that we consider bullish in our analysis (in the breakouts/testing section) but it remains as a hold or partial sell in the table. The conflict here is that the table is more conservative. This will not be an issue with our clients, because our analysis will explain why we are being bullish/bearish on the stock.
