#### **Analysis**

The market was not able to maintain its strength yesterday and witnessed some selling pressure as it tested the 10,300 level. As we know, the 10,300 is our target, followed by 10,500 which is the actual peak that is expected to serve as resistance.

If the EGX 30 declines from here today, our target will be set at 10,000, which is the previously broken peak, and should act as support. Our stronger support, however, lies at 9,600 and is the bottom of this whole sideways range.

As the index is currently trading near its upper boundary, we should wait for a clear break above 10,500 to repurchase, or if the market declines to 10,000 and begins to rebound.


# Small Caps Index/ EGX 70

# Analysis

The EGX 70 index rose slightly yesterday but did not close at the high, which hints of a potential decline on the short-term.

Investors who are short-term in nature can place their trailing stop near 2,200 as a break below this level will lead the index to its bottom that lies around 2,100 or slightly above this level.

On the other hand, we do not recommend buying once again before a clear break above the peak that lies at 2,280.

The 27-27.25 level is still the important resistance for the stock. COMI did not break yet this important peak. We will not recommend stepping in unless this resistance is broken upwards.





Challenging its important resistance that lies at 8-8.15. A confirmed break above this level will trigger an entry signal with a target at 9.





First resistance lies at 3.75. FWRY approached this level but witnessed some selling pressure to close at 3.66. If the stock breaks resistance, a short-term entry signal will be triggered.





The 3.55-3.6 range is an important resistance area for AUTO. A break above this level will lead to a significant rise that will take the stock above 4.


The prices that are accompanied by a green arrow in the above table show resistance levels. Thus, a break above these levels will pave the way to achieve one (or all) of the targets.

#### Tips on reading the report

The first page includes an analysis of two major indices in the Egyptian Stock Market; the norm is that we will analyze both the EGX 30 and 70, but sometimes we will compare the EGX 30 to its 50 counterpart if there is important information in this comparison. We also use the Hermes Last Index interchangeably with the EGX 30. The .HRMSL index has an important edge; it uses last prices instead of VWAP. First thing our clients should do is to read the indices analysis carefully to have a clear understanding on our overall view.

The second page includes stocks that broke out beyond their resistance levels, and those that violated their support levels. It also includes stocks that are testing their support levels and those that are testing their resistance. This analysis is important and it is the core of our recommendations. It is important to note though that not all stocks that are testing their support levels are bullish, and not all that are testing their resistance levels are bearish. To make it easier for our clients, we have placed a bull face if we consider the stock under study bullish, and a bear face if we consider it bearish. We also added a big bullet if we are neutral.

It is important to note that you might find a stock that we consider bullish in our analysis (in the breakouts/testing section) but it remains as a hold or partial sell in the table. The conflict here is that the table is more conservative. This will not be an issue with our clients, because our analysis will explain why we are being bullish/bearish on the stock.
